4. Set up your cameras:

 Combine different video clips from multiple cameras into one sequence.

5. Make sure everything sounds good:

- Sync the audio from all your cameras so it sounds smooth and professional.

6. Edit your video:

- Choose the best parts from each camera angle to create a dynamic and engaging video.

7. Polish your masterpiece:

- Fine-tune your edit for perfect timing and transitions.

8. Add some extra flair:

- Include additional video clips (called B-roll) to make your video even more interesting.

9. Create a 3D title:

- Add a cool 3D title to your video to grab attention.

10. Make your title shine:

- Customize the look and movement of your 3D title to match your video's style.

11. Share your creation:

- Export your finished video in a format that everyone can watch (like H.264).

12. Bonus tip:

 Use a preset to quickly export your video with the right settings.
